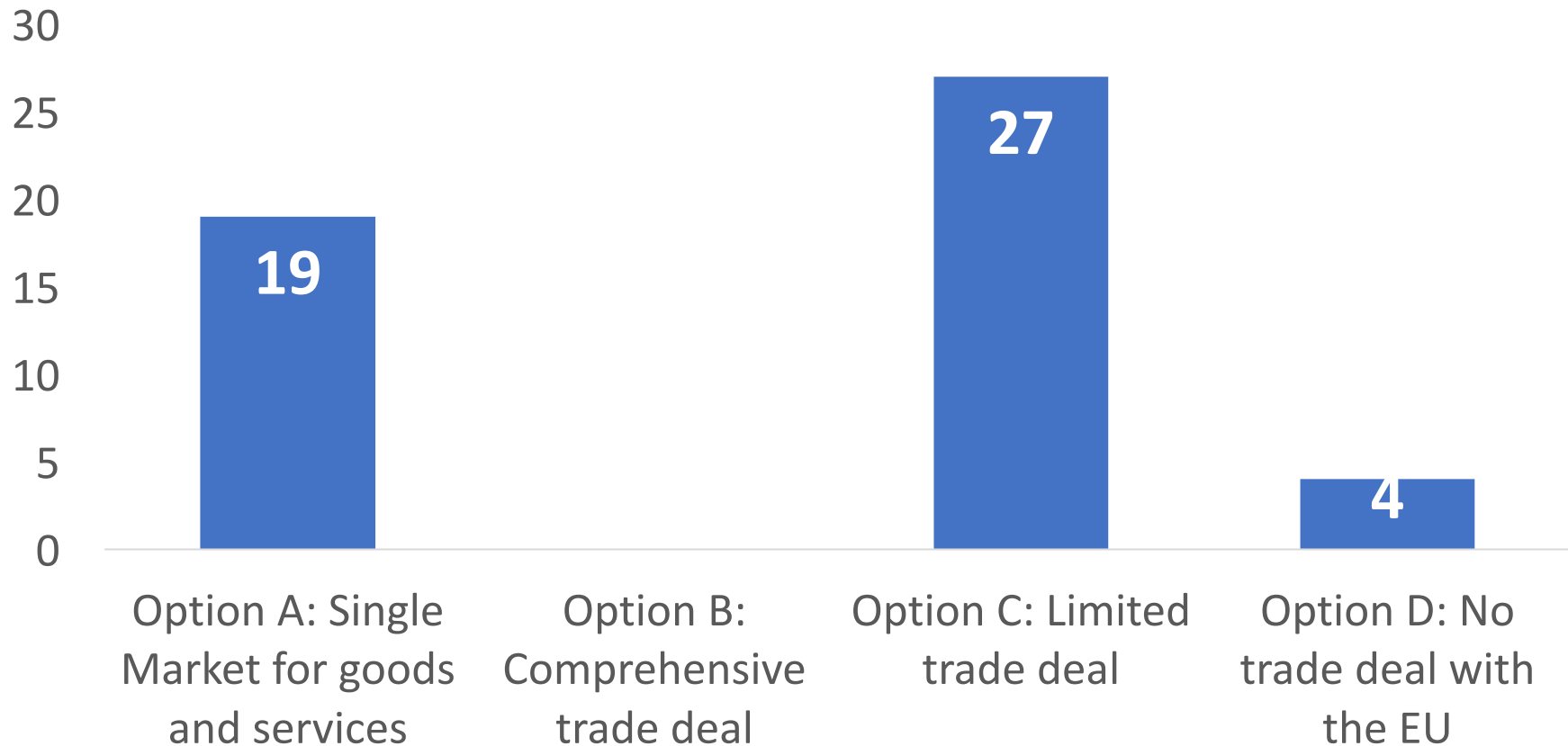

**Do no trade deal with the EU, and allow free movement or favourable access**

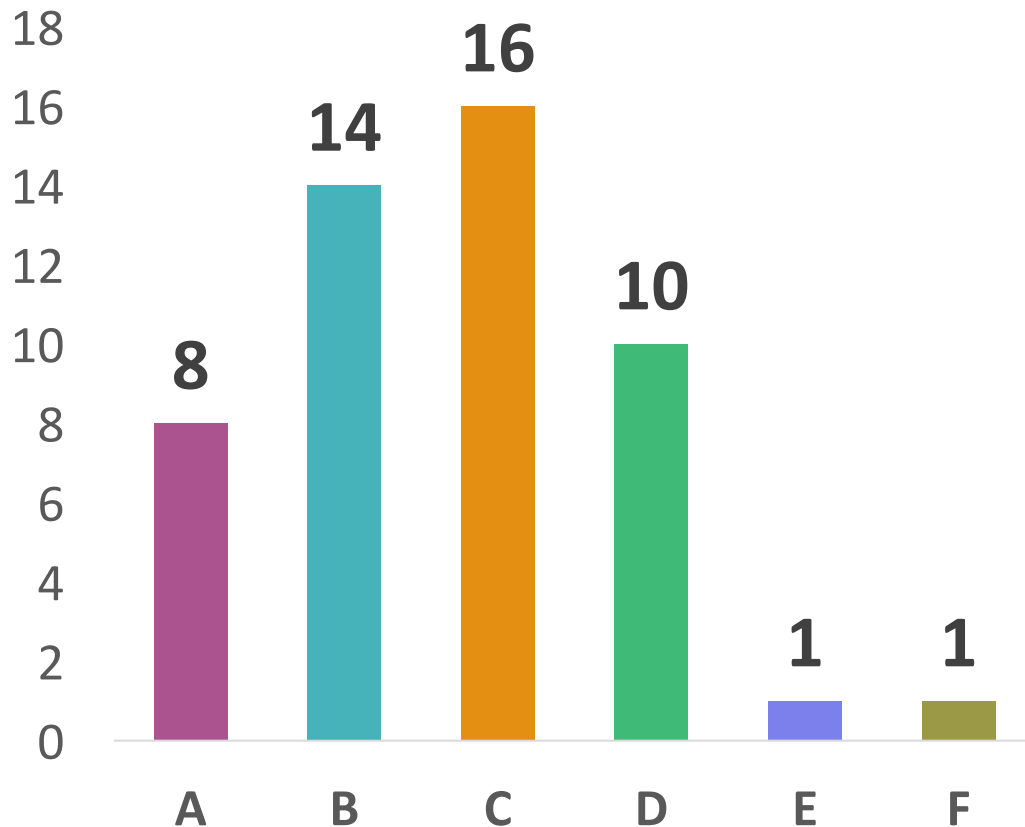
