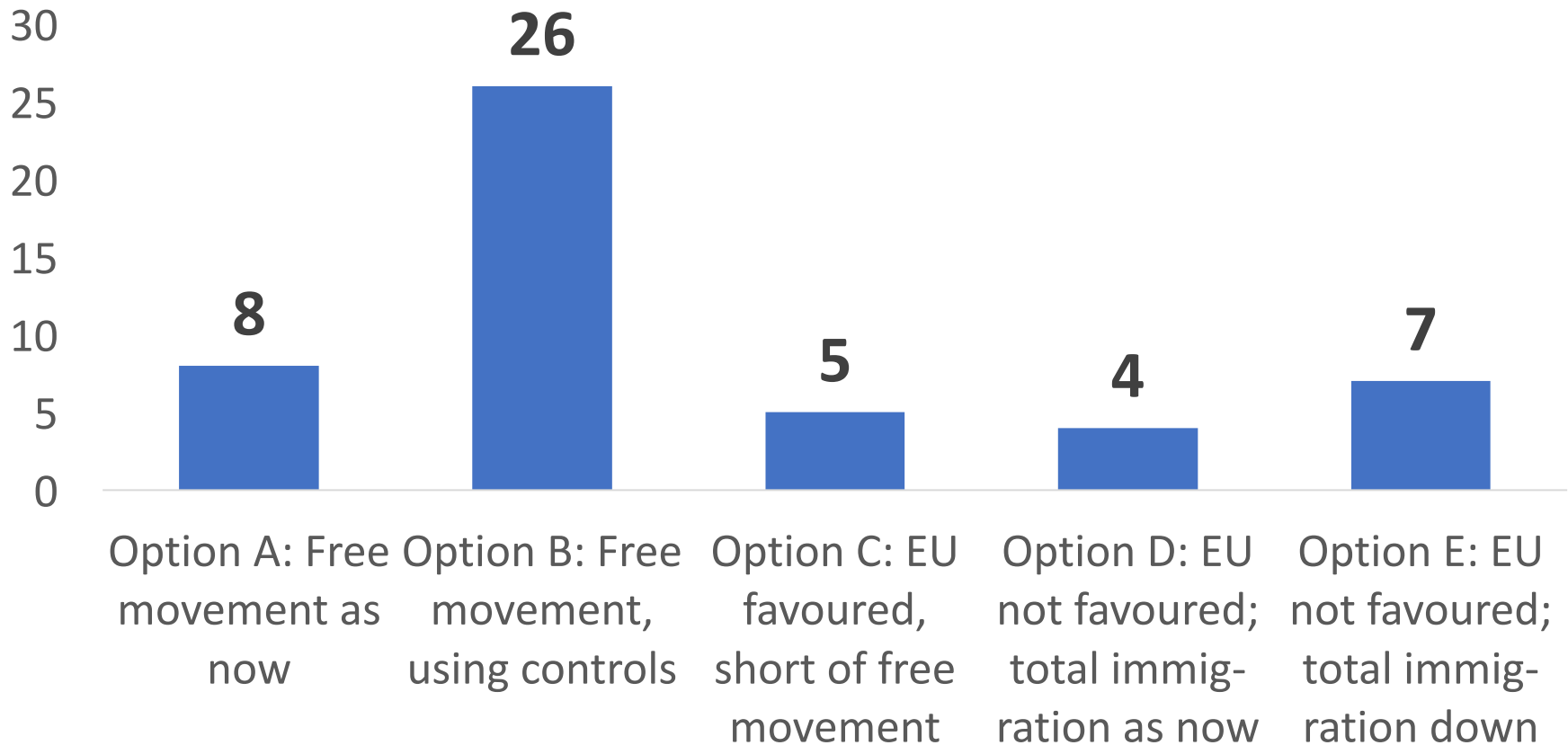

Same rules for EU and non-EU citizens; total immig. lower

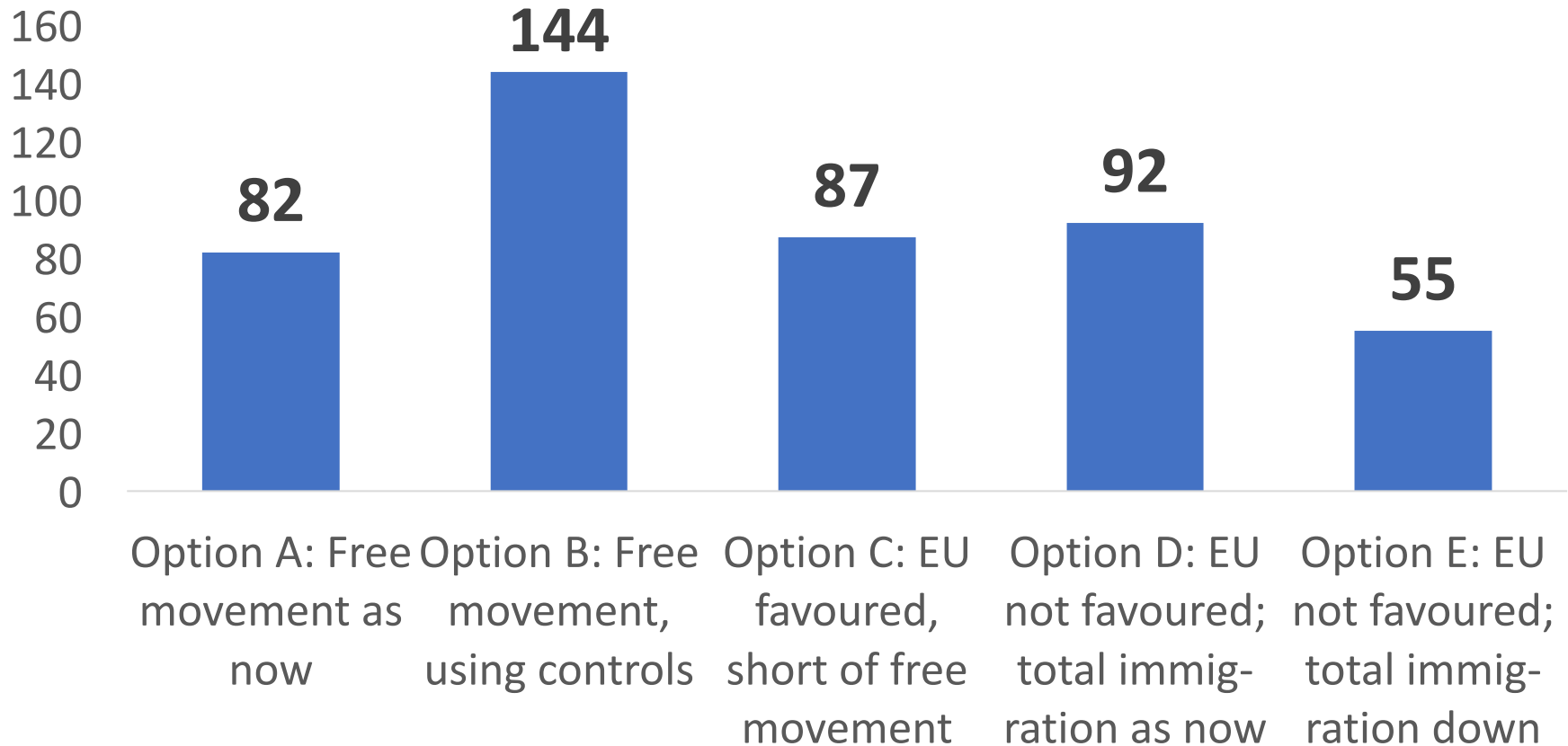

**OPTION
A**

Stay in the Single Market, with free movement of labour as now

**OPTION
B**

Stay in the Single Market, with free movement of labour, using available controls

**OPTION
C**

Do a comprehensive trade deal with the EU, + favourable access short of free movement

**OPTION
D**

Do a more limited trade deal with the EU, with no favourable access for EU citizens

**OPTION
E**

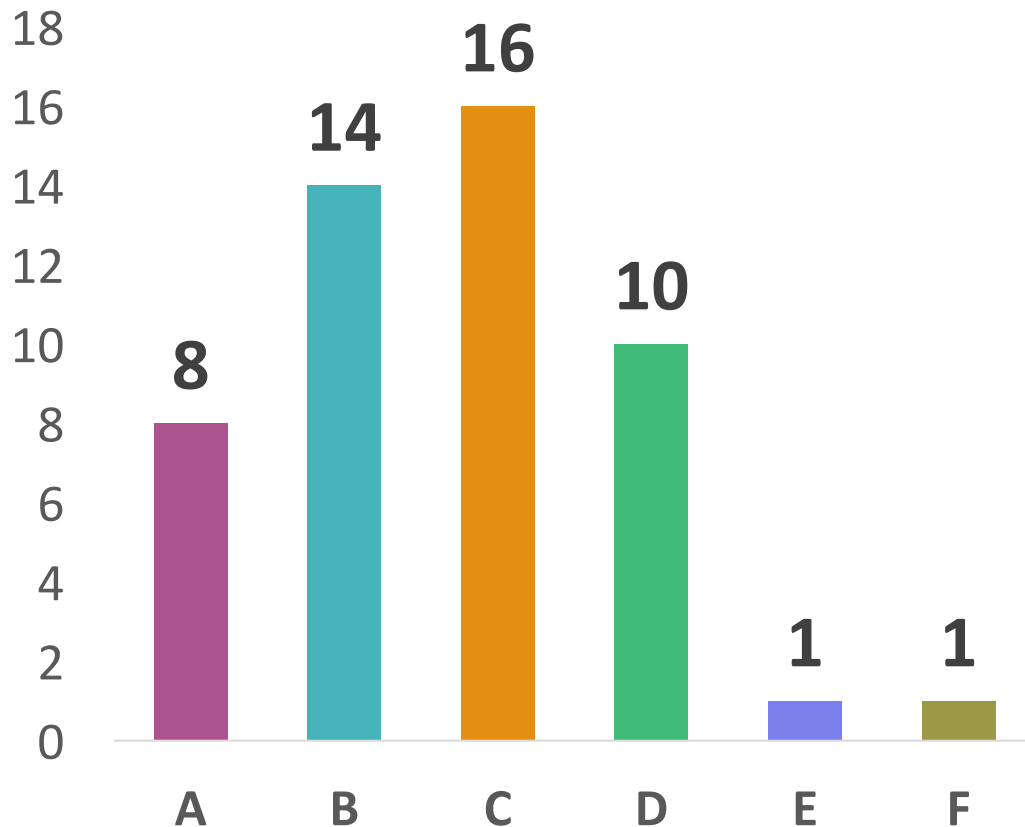
Do no trade deal with the EU, and allow free movement or favourable access

**OPTION
F**

Do no trade deal with the EU, and allow no favourable access for EU citizens

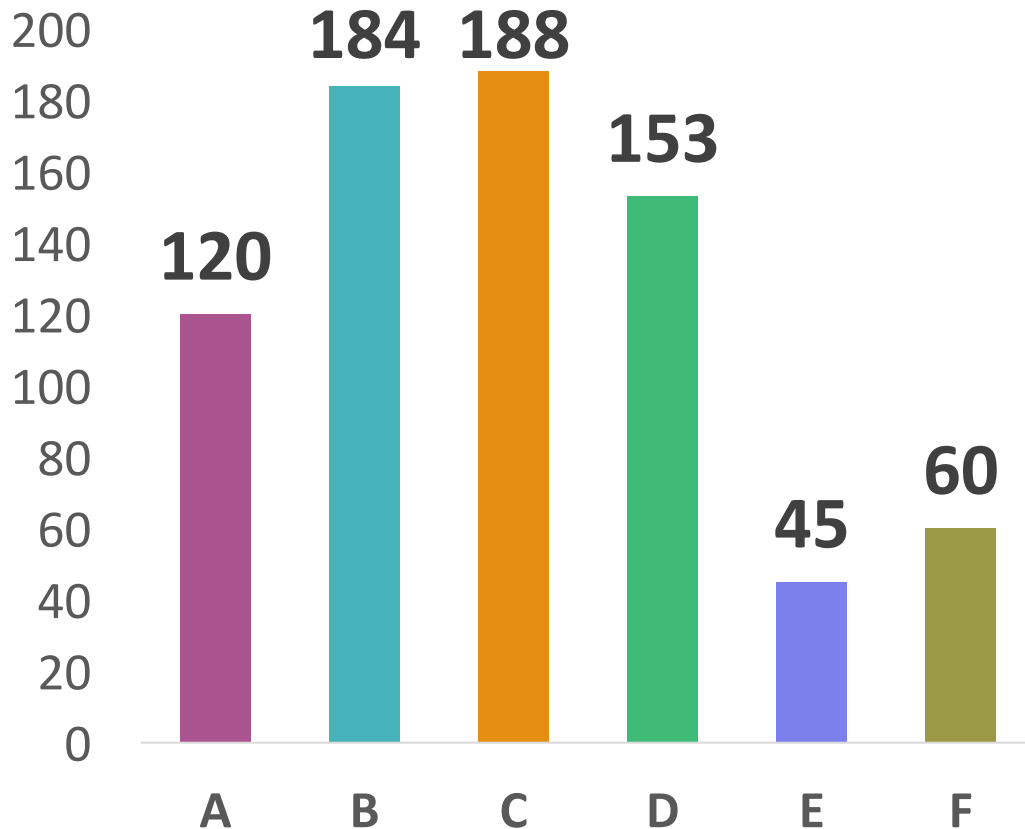

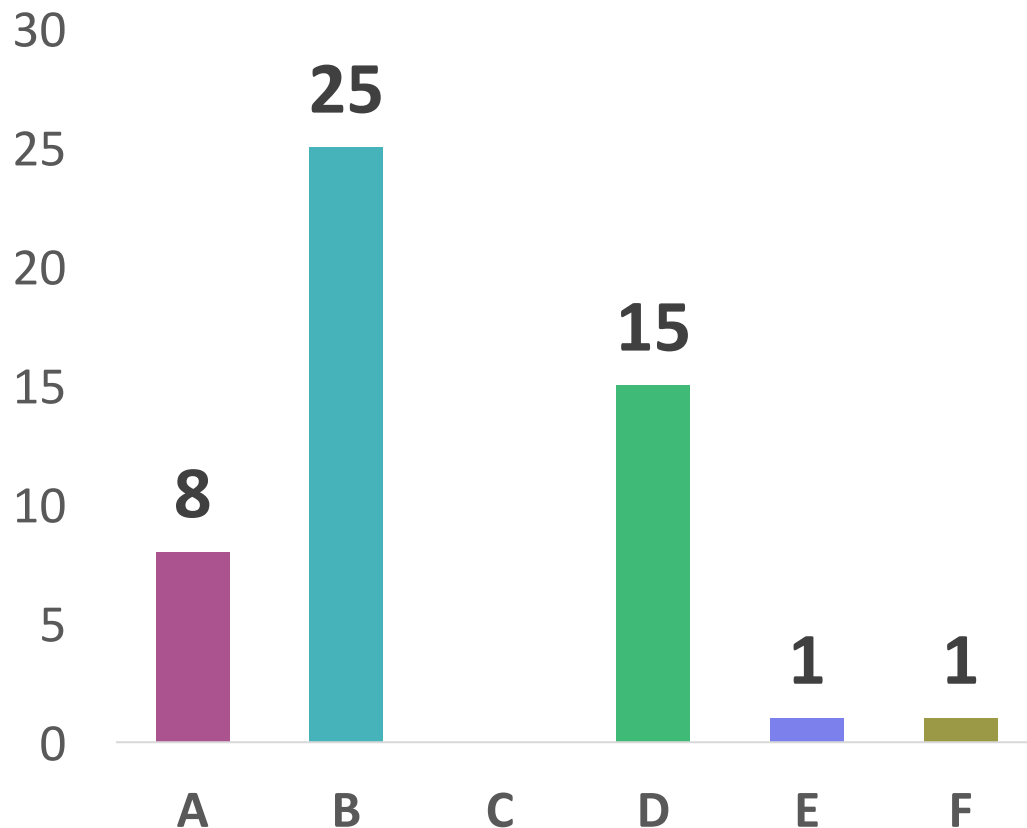

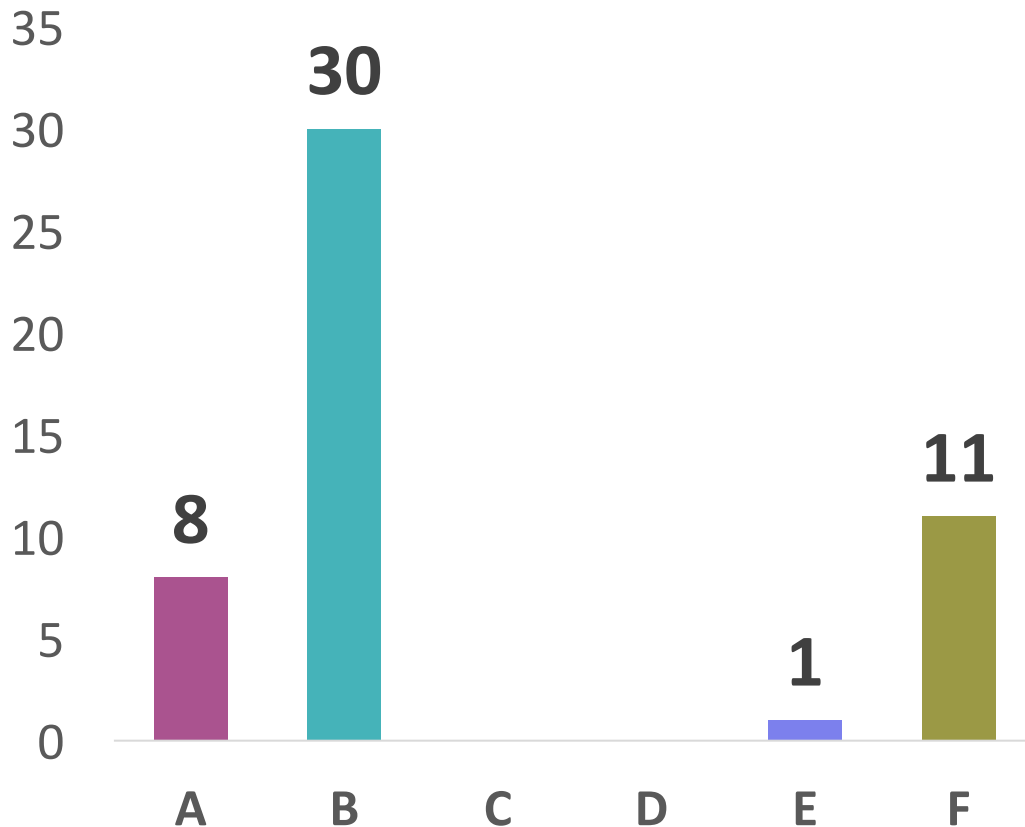
